

Iron Range Amateur Radio Club N8LVQ-R Echolink Programming update 12 November 2018

Thanks much for the hard work and compilation by Paul P W8YNY and Dan B KC8YIO.

When connected via RF or Echolink to the Iron River 145.170 repeater, you can now use the DTMF keypad on microphone to easily connect to other Echolink repeaters. This will NOT work using Echolink app on cell phone. RF link only with keypad on microphone.

DTMF Tone Commands are as follows:

- disconnect

- disconnect all (if multiple nodes)

9999 – Voice recorder playback to check audio input level.

10 – KL7M-r Anchorage, Alaska

20 – K5MPH-r Brownsville, Texas

30 – Ireland

40 – KE7UUJ-r Rocksprings, Wyoming

50 – KD8JAM-r Calumet, Michigan

60 – W9VRC-r Eagle River, Wisconsin

70 – ND8M-r Iron Mountain, Michigan

80 – W8YY-r MTU, Houghton, MI

As an example of how to connect to KL7M-r in Anchorage: Enter 10 on your radio Touch Tone keypad and then wait for the voice confirmation of being connected. Wait a few seconds to listen for any traffic, then make your call. **When you're done, enter # to disconnect.**
